Late Reverend Richard Wurmbrand spent 14 years in Romanian communist prisons. Mrs. Wurmbrand was imprisoned for nearly three years, also for her Christian faith in some of the same communist prisons.

#### THE SPIRITUALLY DEAD!

In a small town, the hearse driver was an unbeliever. The pastor of the church had tried repeatedly to convert him. The efforts did not succeed. One day, the car of the pastor was out of use. He had to take a burial service. So, he sat in the hearse near the driver. He made a new attempt to bring the driver to conversion. So, he told him. "Sir, would you, please, render me a service. The Bible contains a difficult verse which speaks about your profession. Help me to understand it. Our Lord Jesus says, `Let the dead bury their dead.' Now, a dead hearse driver cannot drive a corpse to the cemetery. A dead grave digger cannot dig a grave. A dead pastor cannot deliver a funeral sermon. What is then the meaning of these words?" The driver laughed, "Have I not always told you, pastor, that the Bible is sheer nonsense? Take these words of Jesus only and you have the proof of it." The pastor said, "Before discarding it, let us consider it a little bit. When the coffin with the dead man whom we have behind us was taken out of the house, you heard his wife crying, `George, don't leave me alone. Return!' The children also begged their father to stay with them. It was in vain. The dead did not answer because he was dead. The same happens with you. Since years, Christ, the angels, Christians call you to repentance and you don't answer, because you also are dead, dead spiritually. And a man who is dead spiritually buries a man who is bodily dead.

The words of our Lord have sense."

Every man who does not have Christ is dead spiritually. Bodily he may live in a nice home. Spiritually his abode is in a grave. Jesus would like to resurrect, him from there, as He resurrected Lazarus bodily, in times ago. Bodily resurrections have been very rare occasions. But the Lord wishes the spiritual resurrection of all those who are dead in sins and error. He asks us, the believers, to be His coworkers in this. He is the only one who can resurrect, but we are called to take away the stones from the graves. In different circumstances, the stones, that is, the causes which hinder the coming to eternal life of sinners are different. There are many modern preachers who proclaim a Prosperity Gospel, ignoring repentance from sin. These false preachers pretend that by "giving money to God, God gives you more money!" In the Bible we find exactly the opposite teaching. Elihu said to Job: "Look unto the heavens, and see; and behold the clouds which are higher than thou. If thou sinnest, what doest thou against him? or if thy transgressions be multiplied, what doest thou unto him? If thou be righteous, what givest thou him? or what receiveth he of thine hand? If thou be righteous, what givest thou him? or what receiveth he of thine hand? Thy wickedness may hurt a man as thou art; and thy righteousness may profit the son of man." (Job 35:5-8) Then there are atheists. They block people from being saved by placing the enormous stone of unbelief called "evolution." They claim that somehow, through billions of years the complex proteins existing in our bodies, the miracle of consciousness evolved from some muck found haphazardly on sea shores. They block faith by pretending man evolved from monkeys. Again, Elihu explains to Job: But none saith, Where is God my maker, who giveth songs in the night; Who teacheth us more than the beasts of the earth, and maketh us wiser than the fowls of heaven? (Job 35: 10-11)

There are left-indoctrinated Christians who praised the social achievements of Mao Tse Tung in China. Already in 1927, MAO wrote an article entitled REPORT ABOUT THE STUDY OF THE PEASANT MOVEMENT IN THE HUNAN PROVINCE. His words are "Revolutions are not made with white gloves. The enemies must not only be overthrown. They must be thrown on the earth and trodden under our feet. In every village we must create for a short time the atmosphere of terror (this "short time" lasted already over 90 years N. Ed.). It is necessary"—he writes—"that whosoever wore once this cap should crawl on the earth all the rest of his life. Never more shall he walk erect, never more be a man." Such are the things which our brethren and sisters and other innocents had and have to suffer in Red China. What a stone on the graves, where the spiritually dead lie! Jesus asks us weeping, "Take ye away the stone."

"Octavia Maria Zetea, daughter of Reverend Zetea Stefan wrote: My father was born 1913, his mother being a widow with 6 children. He became a minister in 1938, married my mother Elvira the following year. We were five siblings (3 boys and 2 girls.) **He raised us in the faith**.

The new communist regime chased us all out of the parochial home in 1948. In 1951 father was arrested, his faith testimony being characterized on the imprisonment warrant and sentencing document, as a "plotting against the (communist) government."


During 27 different prolonged interrogations lasting many hours, he was repeatedly spit in the face, was beaten with rubber truncheons and called "a bandit." Since he did not accept to renounce the faith, he was placed in a solitary cell without food for three days. We his children, were not allowed to complete our school-studies.

When he was set free after about two years, from the Gherla prison (same prison Reverend Richard Wurmbrand was held in also), he continued unafraid his intensive Christian activity in the underground church. She thanks us for our help and asks God reward us!

"My name is Victoria Ribca and I am 27 years old. I was born in the Republic of Moldova, where I spent the first 15 years of my life, in a modest family.

I heard about the Richard Wurmbrand Christian School from the pastor of the church my family and I attended. He told us it was a very good school, both academically and in terms of environment. I immediately had a great wish to get to study there and the pastor told me he would help me with enrollment.

I come from a modest family. Our material and financial means did not allow me to finish my studies, not even the compulsory ones. Both my parents wished that I finish my

studies so you can imagine that we were daydreaming of me going to a Christian school in Iasi, Romania.

The way the Lord worked things out for me to actually become a student at Richard Wurmbrand Christian School was miraculous. So, after talking with my parents, I made the decision to go study at



# **Christians Helped with Your Gifts Suffered Four Years Imprisonment** for his Faith



Augusta Cecilia, the daughter of Reverend Augustin MARE wrote: My father was born in 1928, in Tiream, the Satu Mare County, Romania. He married when 28 and had (before being imprisoned) two children. Two children were born after he was freed from prison. After he became a minister, he was arrested and imprisoned by the communist secret police for four years. He was held and tortured in the most sinister prison camps, at the Danube Canal, also the Sighet, Jilava and Aiud prisons. When he was freed, he was healthwise a completely destroyed person. (N. Ed. The tortures in above named prisons went beyond most gruesome imagination. Christians held in the Danube Canal, where wife of Reverend Richard Wurmbrand, Sabina, was also imprisoned, described how the death of a person was considered of the importance of the death of a fly. At one time the head guard hit someone with a shovel so brutally that he broke his hand. The (communist) commanding officer at the "Five Ridges" Colony at this Canal Prison Camp would force detainees to stretch on the ground and he would dance on their body similarly to the dancing of a bear, as he was way more than 200 lbs. The dead were thrown naked into shallow graves, as due to the freeze the other prisoners could not dig deep. In the spring, dogs were uncovering the graves and eating up these corpses. This was the communist inferno.) My mother was dismissed from her work place and could never get a job. He was told his children would not be allowed to study. It was indeed so. We survived only by divine grace. After the fall of communism in Romania, he became a bishop. I thank you from the bottom of my heart for your help.

Above, a sample only of a long list, our mission was able to compile beside other lists, of over 480 elderly Baptist Christians most of them still alive, who suffered for the Christian faith in the Soviet Union. The former prison sentences amounted from 2 years, to as many as 18 years of communist prison. If considered together, their years of prisonsentences shown in our abbreviated table, would most likely add up to over 2,000 years of prison. The 4th and 5th column together, show year of birth and the most recent country they live in (like Ukraine, Russia, Kazakhstan, Belarus, etc.) We try obtain exact addresses, so we may be able to send encouraging help to those still alive. We were able to send repeated help to about 120 such elderly Russian-speaking Christians and over 110 of other languages. Many of their testimonies you can read in the monthly newsletter.
